

Results from 12 Months of Clemency and Pardons Board Transcripts

The Clemency and Pardons Board provided information on whether a position was provided by the prosecuting attorney and the victim/victim's family on each hearing that occurred with a twelve month period (December 2017, March 2018, June 2018, and September 2018). Below are data extracted from that information.

Information during the twelve months was for a total of 36 hearings.

Of those 36 hearings, the prosecutor:

- (11) Opposed
- (6) Supported
- (7) Deferred to the CPB
- (2) Stated No Position
- (3) Had no information recorded
- (7) Had information recorded but that information did not indicate a position

Of those 36 hearings, the victim or victim's family:

- (4) Opposed
- (5) Supported
- (3) Were unable to be located
- (7) Were not heard from
- (13) Had no information recorded
- (4) Had information recorded but that information did not indicate a position

Of those 36 hearings, the Clemency and Pardons Board decided to:

- (22) Grant
- (14) Deny

Of those 36 hearings, the Governor decided to:

- (1) Deny the request
- (3) Grant a Conditional Commutation
- (7) Grant a Full Pardon
- (11) Decision is still pending
- (14) No decision needed as these were already denied by the CPB

Of the 4 hearings where the victim or the victim's family opposed, the CPB granted 1 and denied 3 of the hearings. The Governor's response to the granted hearing result is pending.

Of the 11 hearings where the prosecutor opposed, the CPB granted 2 and denied 9 of the hearings. Of the two granted hearing results, the Governor granted a Conditional Commutation to 1 and the other is pending.

Of the 3 hearings where the victim/victim's family AND the prosecutor opposed, the CPB denied all three hearings.
