**SGC voted on 11/13/20 to support application of ERT on enhancements per DOC's draft language. The SRA Review report also included the recommendation to eliminate mandatory stacking and apply ERT. However, there has not been discussion about elimination of the Criminal Street Gang enhancement that is included in the bill.
