Hearings scheduled for week of 1/23/2023

- a. [HB 1268](#) Concerning sentencing enhancements
- b. [HB 1324](#) Concerning the scoring of prior juvenile offenses in sentencing range calculations.
- c. [HB 1396](#) Concerning persons sentenced for aggravated first degree murder committed prior to reaching 21 years of age.

FYI - Similar bills on the horizon:

- i. [HB 1325/SB 5451](#) Allowing qualifying persons serving long sentences committed prior to reaching 25 years of age to seek review for possible release from incarceration
- ii. [HB 1383](#) Concerning people convicted of one or more crimes committed before the person's 18th birthday petitioning the indeterminate sentence review board for early release
- d. [SB 5160](#) Concerning organized retail theft.

Bills from last week

- a. [HB 1002](#) Increasing the penalty for hazing.
- b. [HB 1150](#) Creating the offense of unlawful branding of another person.
- c. [HB 1160](#) Concerning an aggravating circumstance for the mutilation or dismemberment of a human body.
- d. [SB 5032](#) Extending the felony driving under the influence lookback to 15 years while providing additional treatment options through the creation of a drug offender sentencing alternative for driving under the influence.
