II. DRAFT LEGISLATIVE BILLS

Hearings scheduled for week of 1/8/2024

- a. HB 1961 Concerning animal cruelty in the first degree.
- b. HB 1994 Concerning judicial dismissal of a misdemeanor following completion of court-ordered conditions.
- c. HB 2048 Concerning supervision of domestic violence in criminal sentencing.

Bills not yet scheduled a hearing

- d. HB 1967 Excluding any person who is convicted of a hit and run resulting in death from being eligible for a first-time offender waiver.
- e. HB 1995/SB 5893 Providing gate money to individuals releasing from custody prior to the expiration of their sentence.
- f. HB 1999 Concerning fabricated intimate or sexually explicit images and depictions.
- g. HB 2001 Providing judicial discretion to modify sentences in the interests of justice.
- h. HB 2002 Establishing criminal penalties for the public use of fentanyl or methamphetamine.
- i. HB 2030 Revoking a person's voting rights only when convicted of a state crime punishable by death.
- j. HB 2065 Recalculating sentencing ranges for currently incarcerated individuals whose offender score was increased by juvenile convictions.
- k. HB 2078 Improving school safety by extending and increasing penalties for interference by, or intimidation by threat of, force or violence at schools and school-related athletic activities.

- 1. HB 2079 Improving school safety by extending and increasing penalties for interference by, or intimidation by threat of, force or violence at schools and athletic activities.
- m. SB 5891 Designating trespassing on a public school bus as a felony offense.
- n. Possible bill related to adding missing perspectives to the Sex Offender Policy Board
