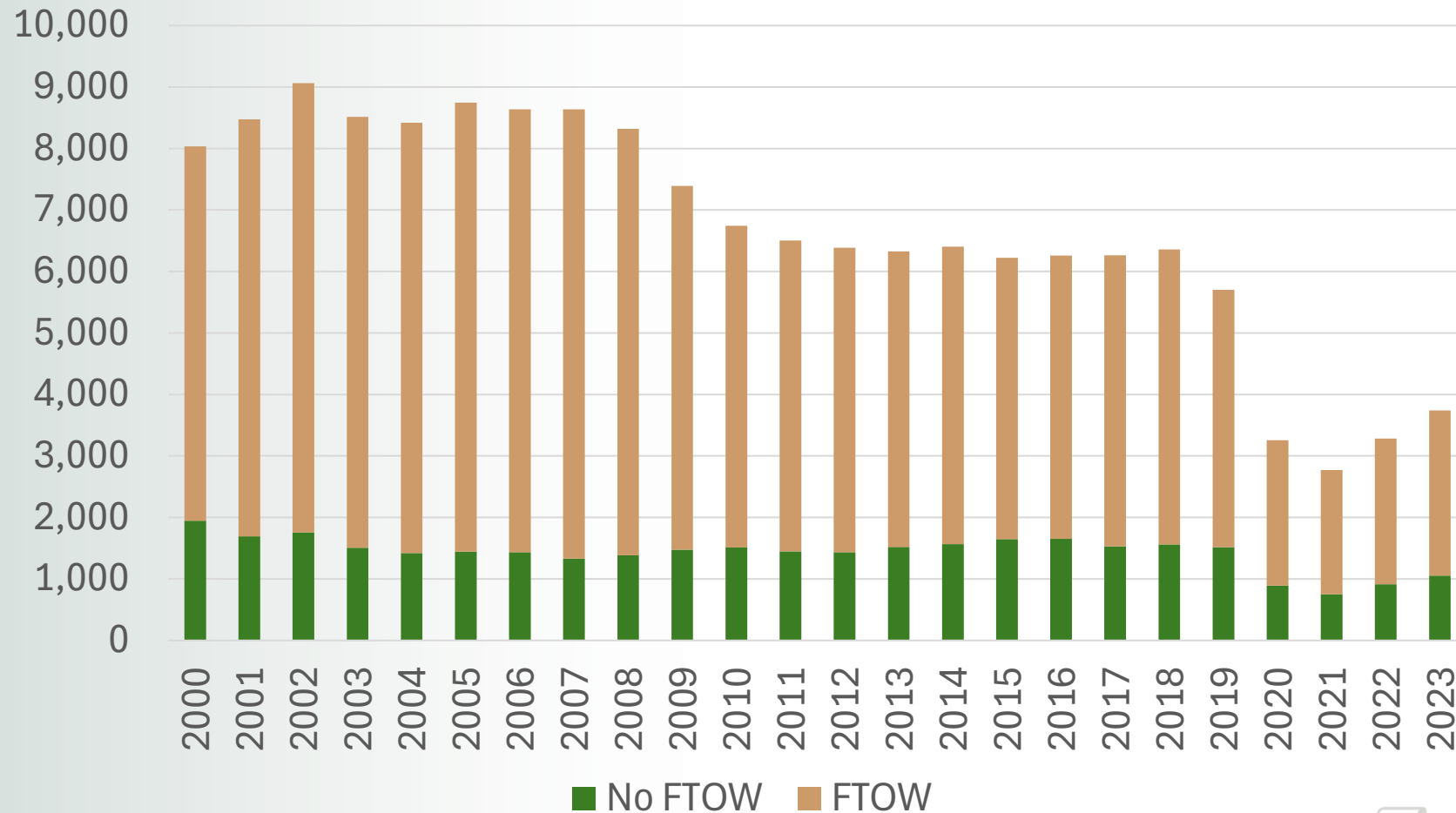

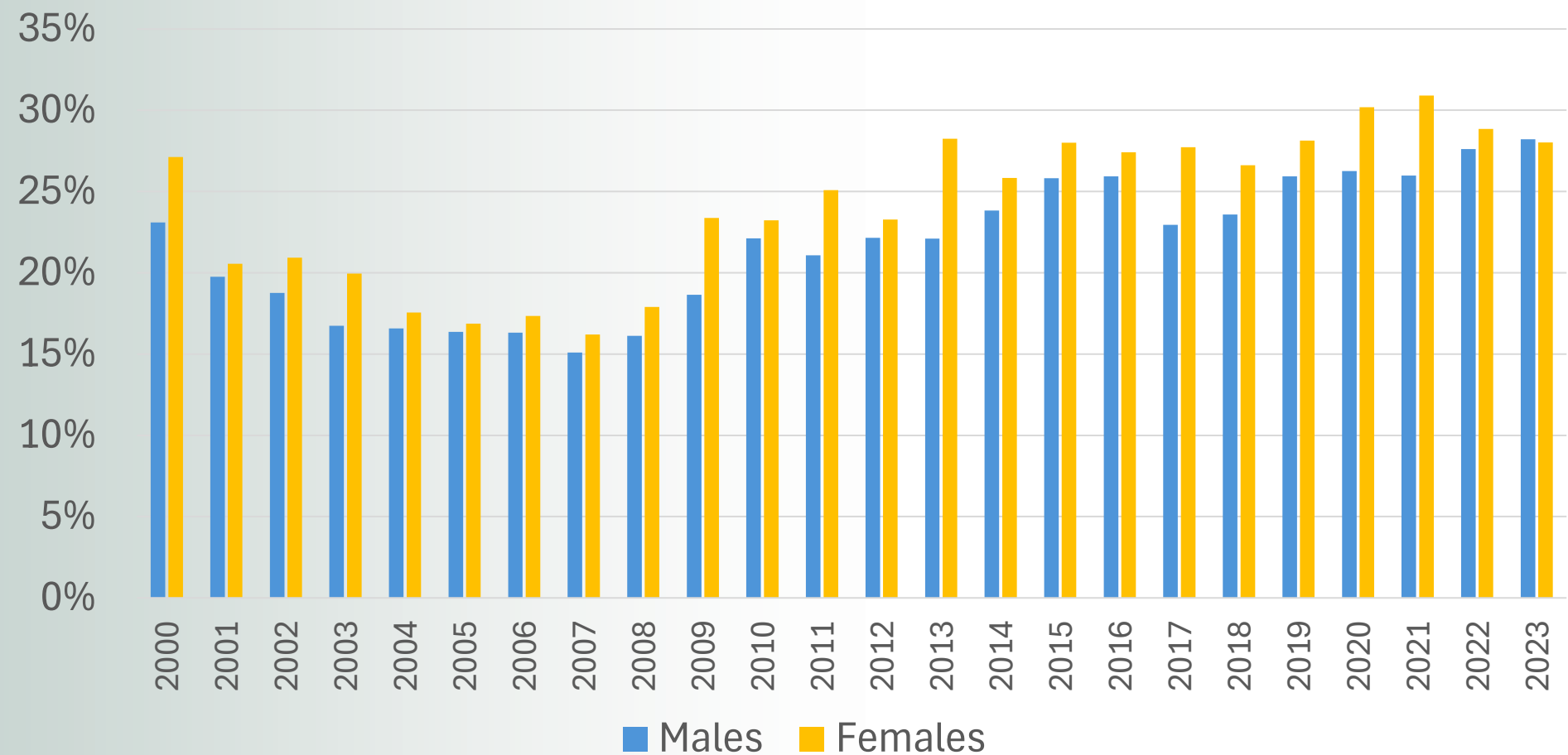

Imposition by Sex

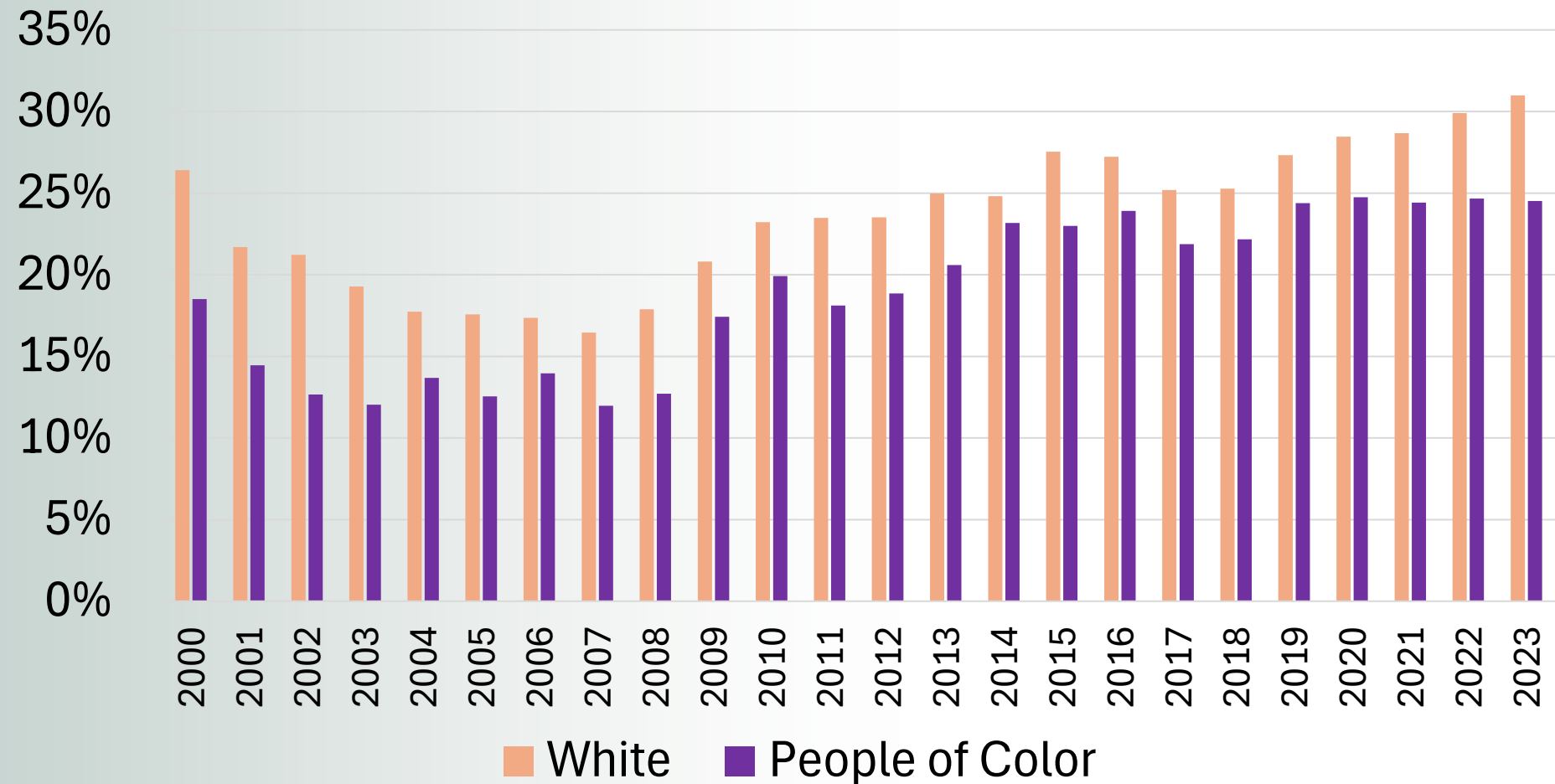
Rate of FTOW Imposition by Sex

Rate of FTOW Imposition by Race

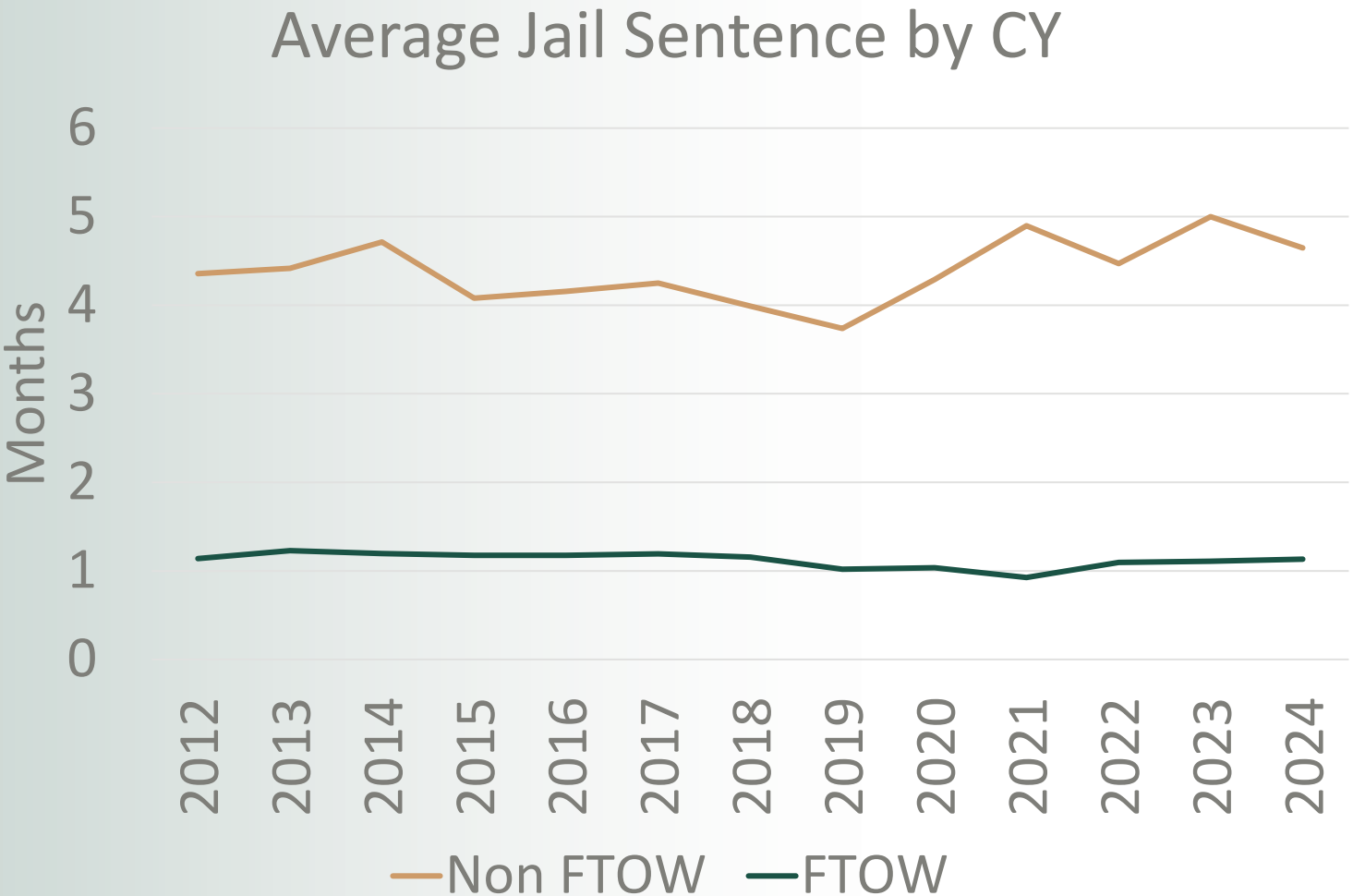


White more likely to receive FTOW when eligible.

Jail Time

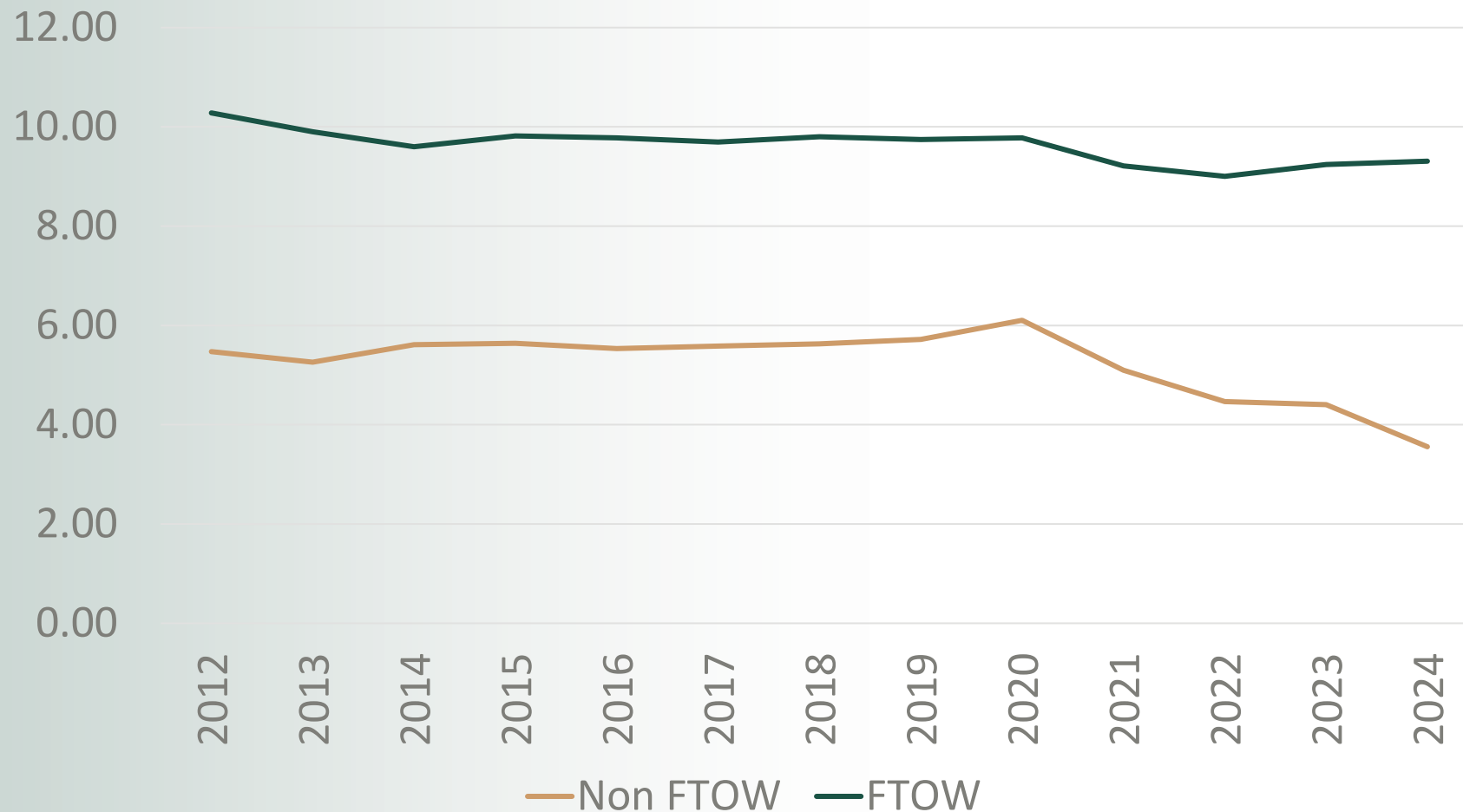


Since 2012-2024:

- 60% of FTOW sentences have 1 month term of jail or less.
- 79% of FTOW sentences 2 month term of jail or less.

Community Supervision

Since 2012-2024:

- 72% of FTOW sentences have 12 month term of community supervision
- 17% of FTOW sentences have 6 month term of community supervision
